



## BACK-UP BATTERY INSTALLATION

Dear member,

You will find in this document the instructions to install the back-up battery for your residential phone. This battery offers you about 8 hours of autonomy for your phone in case of a power outage.

In the box, you will find the CyberPower battery and two cables: the beige one to connect the battery with the Noka modem and the black one to plug the battery into a power outlet. The battery is already charged and ready to be installed.

On the other side of this document you will find instructions on how to connect the back-up battery to the Nokia modem yourself.

**Please read these instructions carefully before proceeding with the installation.**

# INSTRUCTION:

## How to install the Back-Up Battery

In the back-up battery box, you will find:

- The CyberPower battery
- A beige cable
- A black power cable.



Back-up battery

In order to connect the battery backup, you must have access to the Nokia modem. This is the white device, installed during the technician's visit.



Nokia Modem

Here's how to connect the back-up battery:

1. **Unplug the black power cable (1) from the back of the Nokia modem.** You no longer need this cable but you must keep it if you cancel the telephony eventually. Handle the Nokia modem carefully to limit damage on the fiber optic connection.

### ATTENTION

Your Phone and Internet Services will no longer work as soon as the modem is disconnected from electricity.

2. Where the black power cable (1) was plugged in, **insert one of the connectors from the beige cable (2) supplied into the box.**
3. Then, **plug the other connector of the beige cable (3) into the backup battery,** as shown on the picture.
4. Now, take the black power cable that came with the battery and plug it into the connector (4)
5. Finally, **plug the other end of the black power cable into a power outlet.** After about 1 minute, the indicator lights on the Nokia modem will come on. You will then be able to use your services as usual.

During a power outage, you can stop the alarm by pressing "**Alarm Silence**", located at the top left corner of the battery.
